PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO.4 (PART) STREETHAY PARISH PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2024

This Order is made by Staffordshire County Council ("the Authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Mr and Mrs R Summerfield, The Bungalow, Watery Lane, Curborough, Lichfield, Staffordshire WS13 8ES have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Lichfield District Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the District of Lichfield require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the Map and Statement.

BY THIS ORDER

- 1. The public right of way over the land situate northwest of Netherstowe Lane, Curborough in the Parish of Streethay and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up with effect from the date on which Staffordshire County Council certify that the works to bring the new site of the footpath, described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order, into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out to their reasonable satisfaction, and thereupon the Definitive Map for the area shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
- 2. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers

shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

3. There shall upon the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate northwest of Netherstowe Lane in the Parish of Streethay described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order and thereupon the Definitive Map for the area shall be modified by adding that path to it.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The full width of that part of Public Footpath Streethay No. 4 commencing at Grid Reference 413116 311719 (Point A on the map) and running in a generally westnorth-westerly direction for some 260 metres to Grid Reference 412886 311837 (Point B on the map).

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

Public Footpath commencing at Grid Reference 413111 311716 (Point C on the map) running in a generally west-north-westerly direction for some 137 metres to Grid Reference 412983 311762 (Point D on the map) turning north-north-easterly for some 34 metres to Grid Reference 412987 311794 (Point E on the map) then west-north-westerly for some 20 metres to Grid Reference 412968 311800 (Point F on the map) then south-south-westerly for some 25 metres to Grid Reference 412958 311778 (Point G on the map) then west-north-westerly and northerly for some 100 metres to Grid Reference 412886 311837 (Point B on the map).

The new footpath shall have a width of 1.8 metres throughout its length.






