Dear Resident,

Notification of overnight carriageway reconstruction works on the A511 Horninglow Street and Guild Street, Burton Upon Trent

As part of the Council's ongoing investment into its roads in Staffordshire, Amey Services Ltd working with Staffordshire County Council, will shortly begin carrying out works on the A511 Horninglow Street and Guild Street. Works will take place from Brewers Close on Horninglow Street and after the entrance to the National Brewery Centre on Guild Street. Works will include the removal of the existing carriageway surface and replacing it with a new surface, along with other preparation works known as civil works.

From **Monday 1 July 2024**, we'll begin the first phase of the scheme. This will include work on the damaged drainage systems, replacement and adjustments of kerbs where necessary and minor footway patching. The civil works are due to be completed by **Friday 5 July 2024**.

Following on from the civil works, we will begin our carriageway reconstruction works, this will include the re-setting and replacement of carriageway ironworks, the removal of the existing carriageway surface and replacing it with a new surface, along with the replacement of new traffic loops and road markings. Works will take place **from Monday 8 July to Friday 12 July 2024 and Tuesday 16 July to Friday 19 July 2024**.

To allow this scheme of work to be carried out safely, and to minimise disruption, we'll be working overnight between the hours of **19.00pm to 6am (Monday to Friday)** when traffic volumes are lower.

Due to the size and scale of construction machines being used and to ensure the safety of the general public and workforce, sections of the carriageway will at times become impassable and therefore, it will be necessary to close Guild Street after the entrance to Middleway Retail Park to the junction of A511 Horninglow Street to through traffic during the overnight works. The road closures will be in place from **19.00pm to 6am (Monday to Friday)**.

Please see the table on page 3, which provides details about the road closures, working times for the overnight work, along with details about the phases of work.

Local signed diversion routes will be in place during the closures; along with designated personnel at either end of the closure points to offer assistance and assist with access when safe to do so to residential properties and businesses.

Please plan ahead and allow extra time for your journeys.

Pedestrian access along the length of the works will be maintained throughout the works.

Throughout the overnight works, the A511 Horninglow Street will have temporary traffic signals and lane closures in place, to allow us to work on one side of the carriageway. This will minimise disruption to the local community and road users, limit the need for full road closures and diversions, and allow the work to take place safely.

Additional signage will be placed at key strategic points, directing members of the public wanting to access and park for the Manzil Gold restaurant during the overnight closures.

Emergency services will be given access through the road closures.

Unfortunately, with any major highway works, some disturbance is unavoidable, and there may be short delays even on the approaches to the closure points. I must ask that you drive carefully and slowly through any sections of live roadworks for both the workforces and your own safety.

The works may at times be noisy, and we apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disturbance caused. We'll do our best to complete the work as quickly and safely as possible. We like to thank you for your patience during this works.

Please note that all dates are subject to change due to operational requirements and weather conditions.
