

Having received your support, we are happy to report that we will be taking the majority of the improvements forward into the next phase of delivery – detail design.

Following concerns raised during the public consultation, we will not be progressing three elements of the improvements:

- Slow down traffic between Worthington Way and the rail station
- Make Station Street one-way from Worthington Way to Union Street
- If not one-way, two-way widen pavement opposite Wyllie Mews

As a result of your feedback we are now looking to progress

the designs and delivery timescale.

reducing the speed of the traffic between Guild Street and Worthington Way only.
